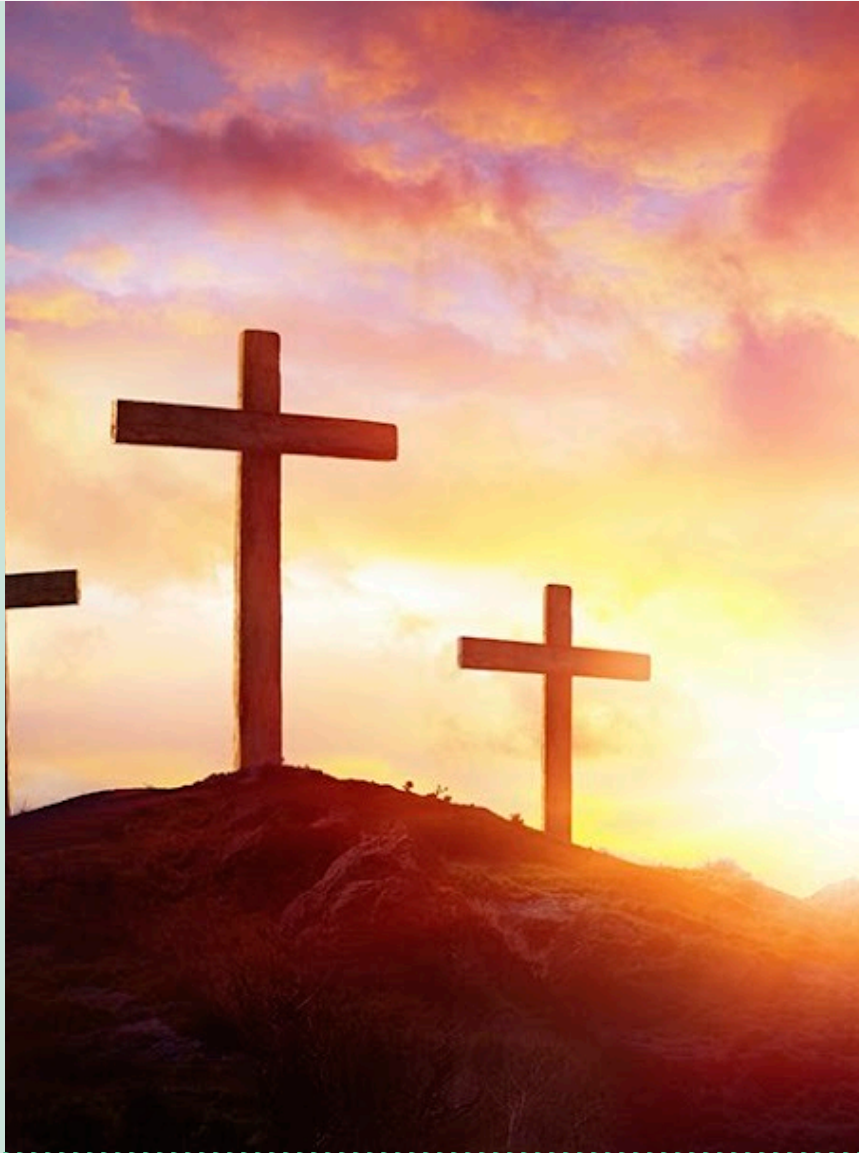

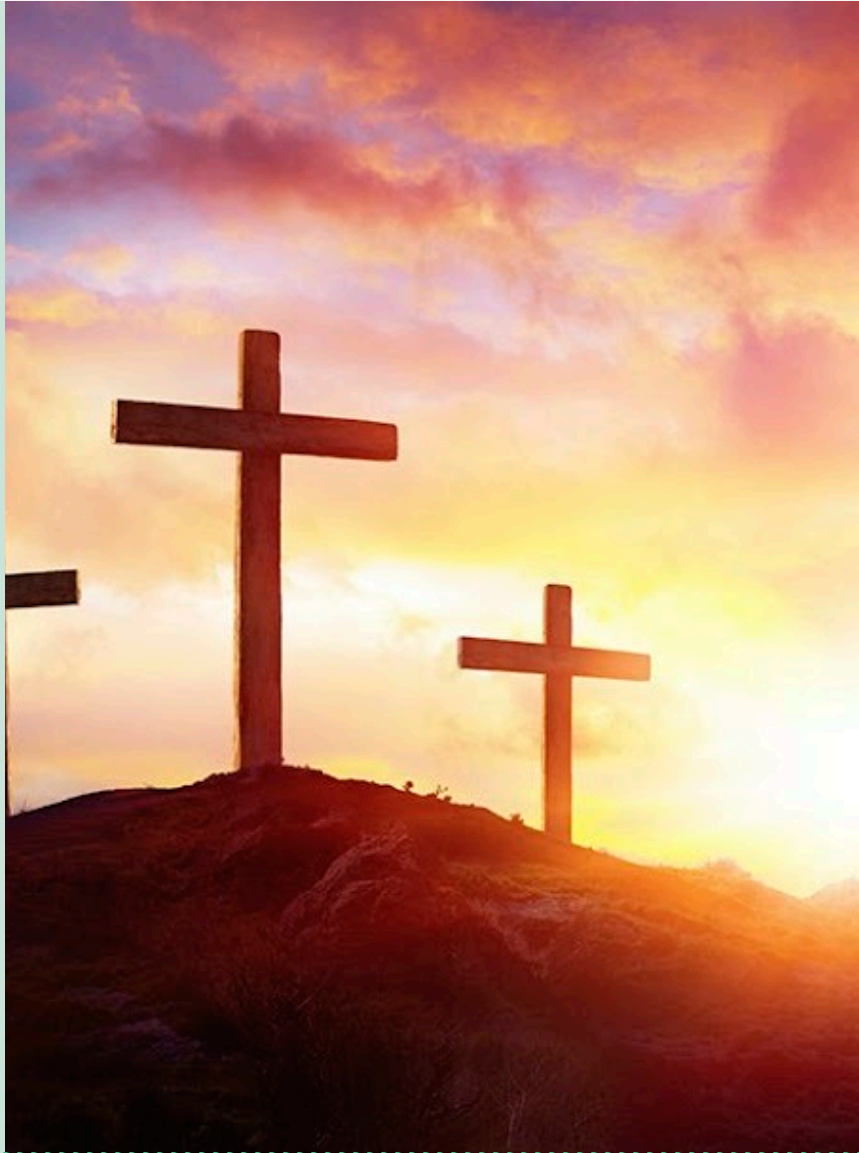


1. Affirm Your Faith in Christ

said in His Word

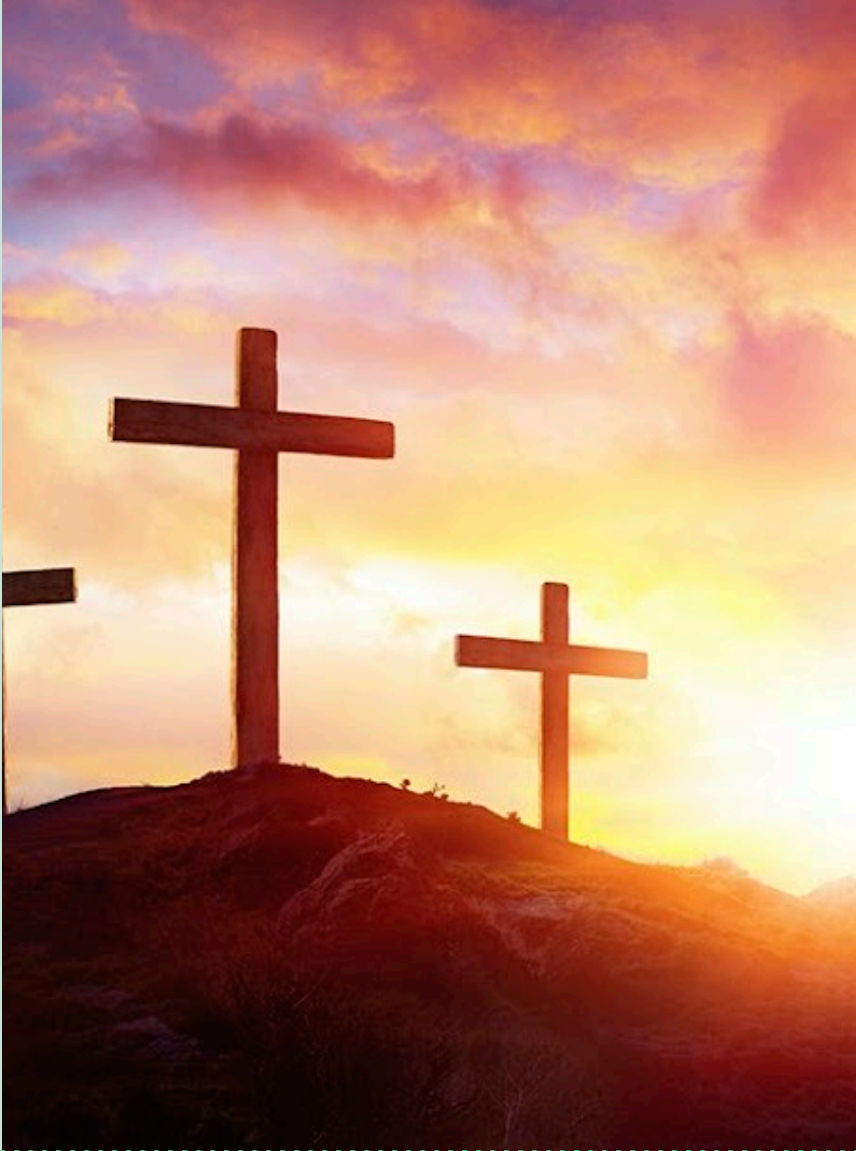


2. Humble Yourself

1 Pet. 5:6

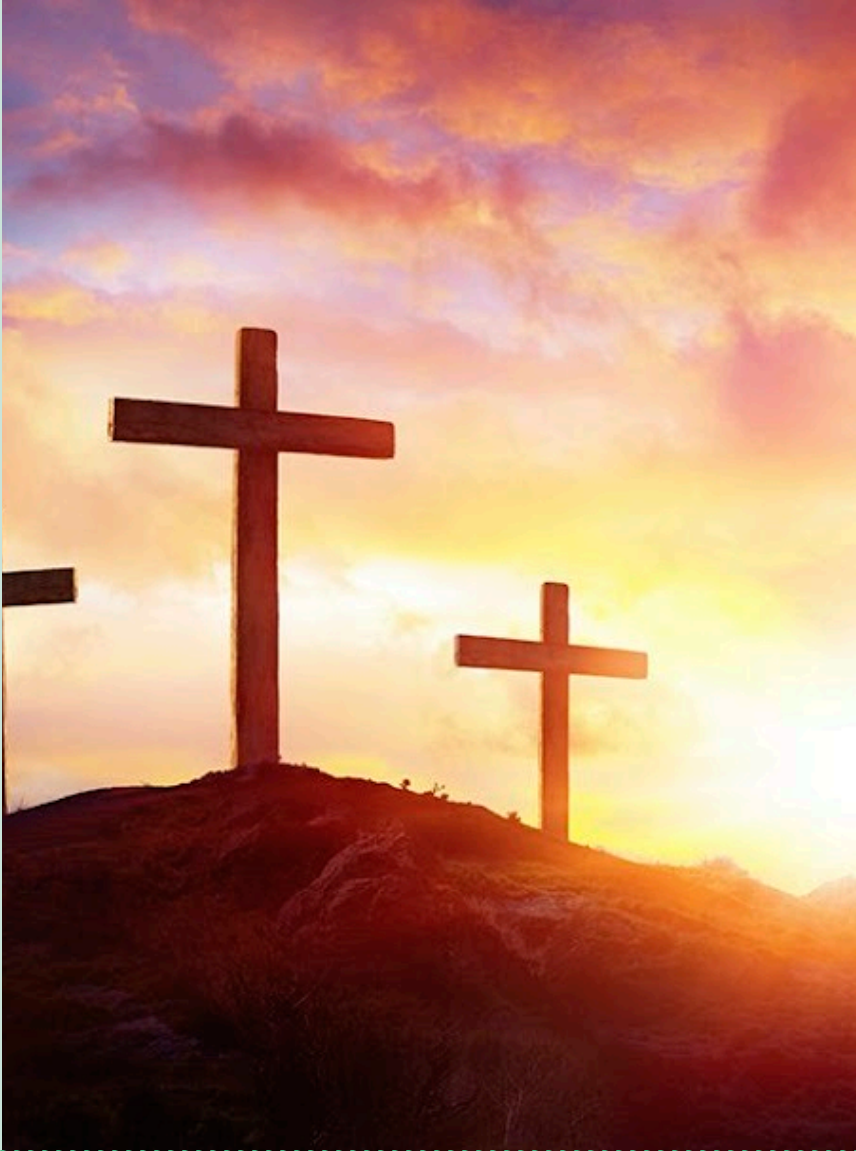
**sacrifice your dignity to get your deliverance*

4. Repent of All Sins

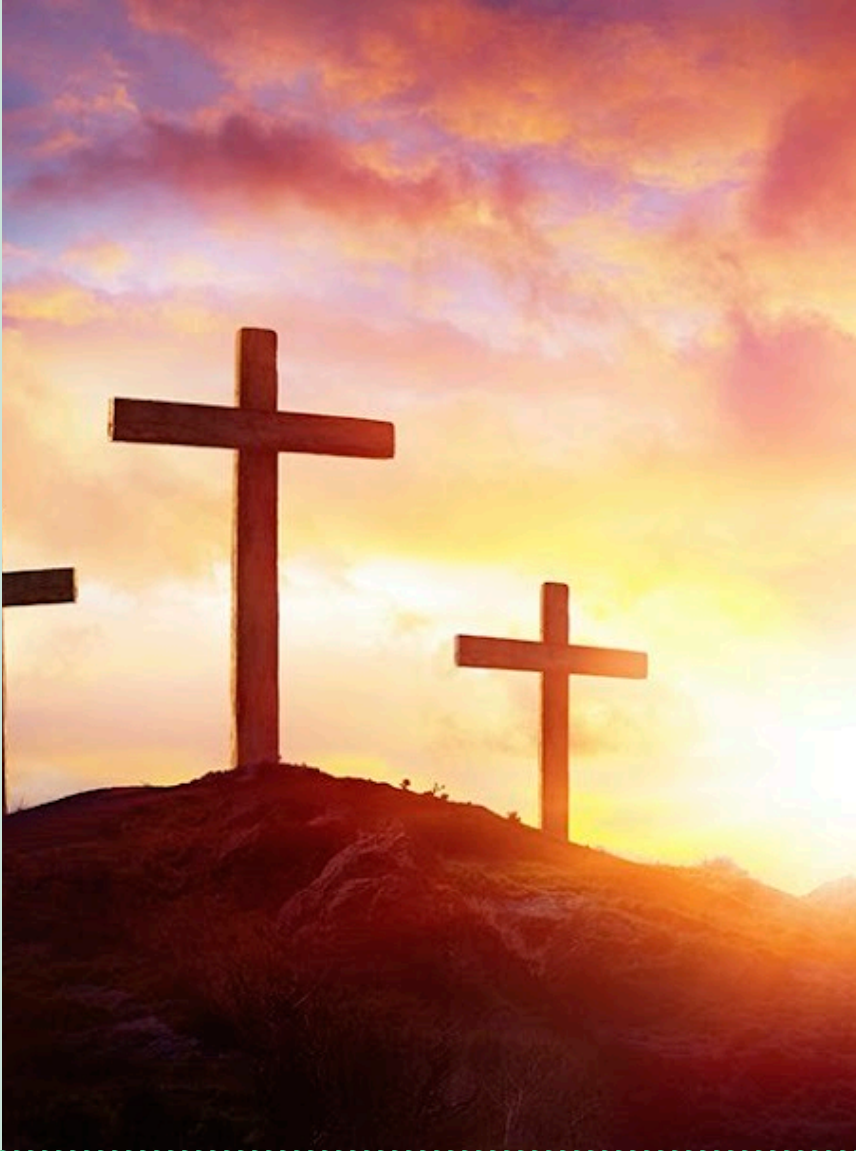
He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.

5. Forgive all People

And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

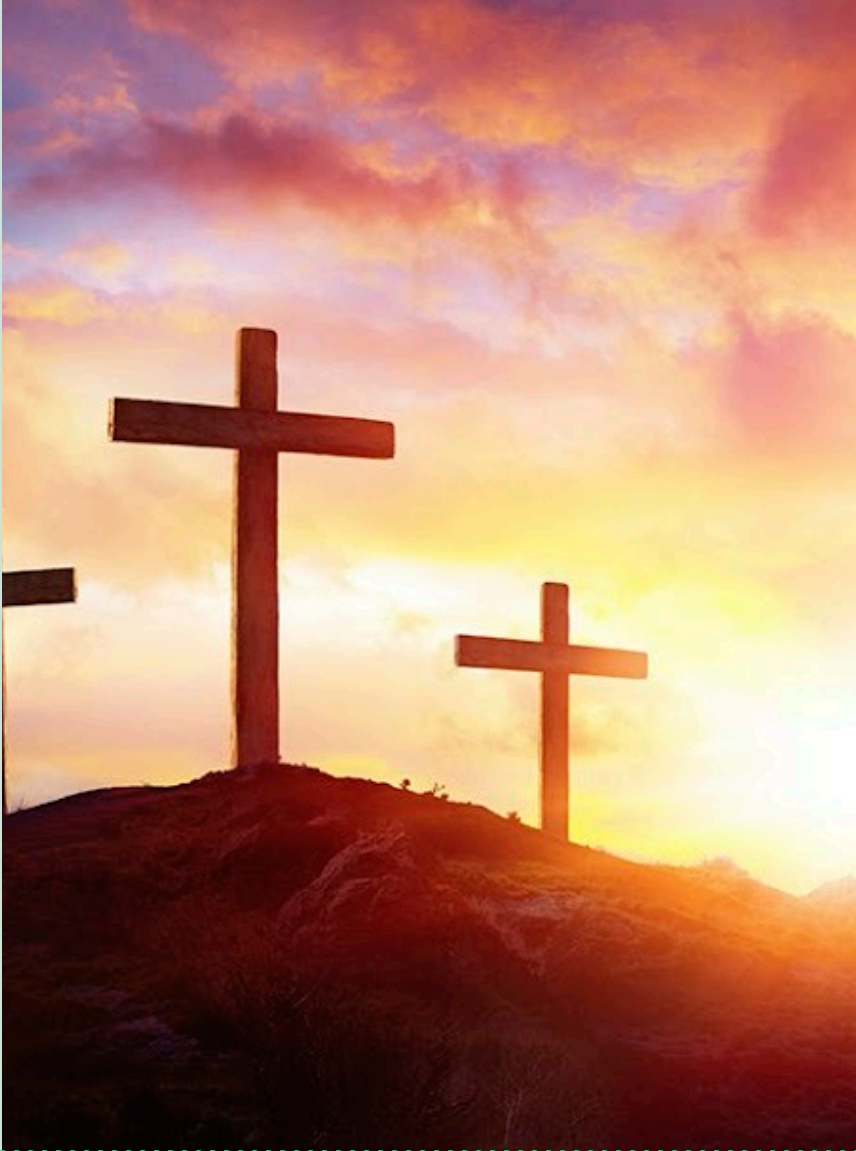

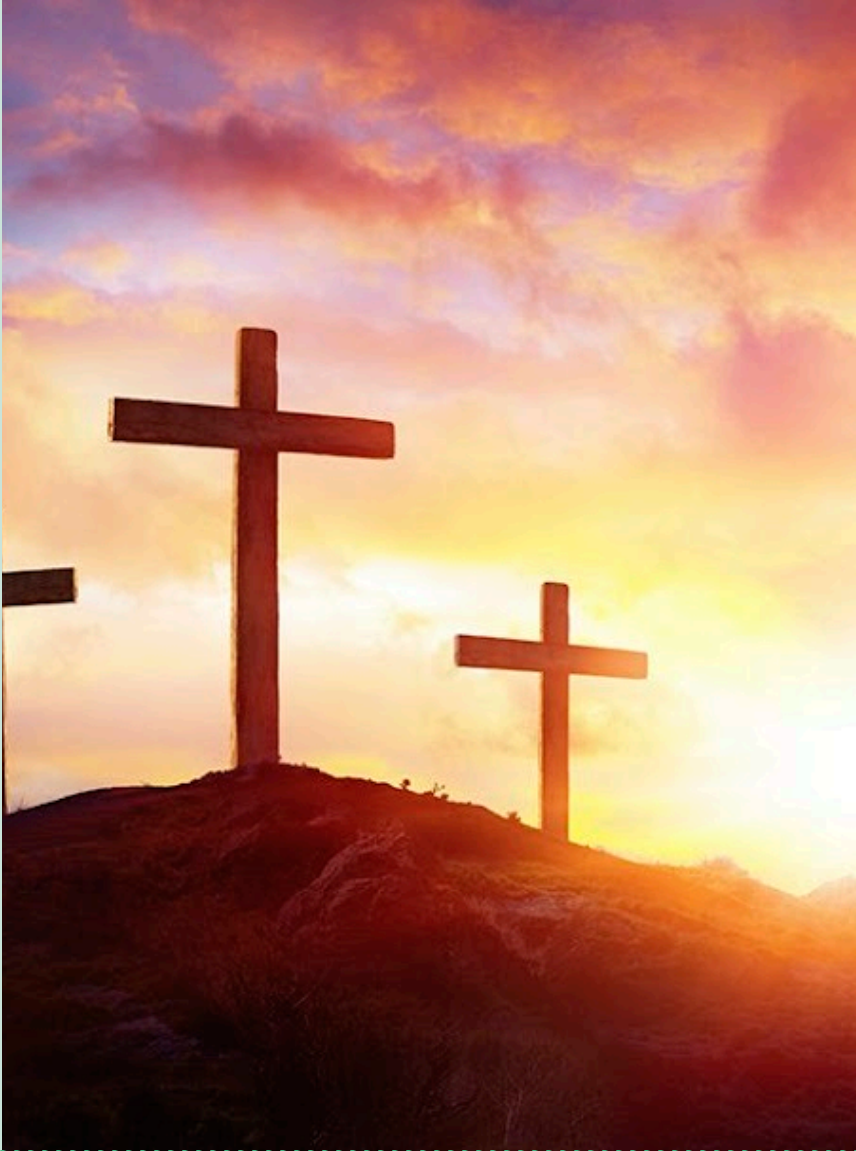

6. Sever Contact with the Occult

Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: but thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it is a cursed thing. Deut. 7:26

7. Prepare to be Released

Signs that curses may be at work

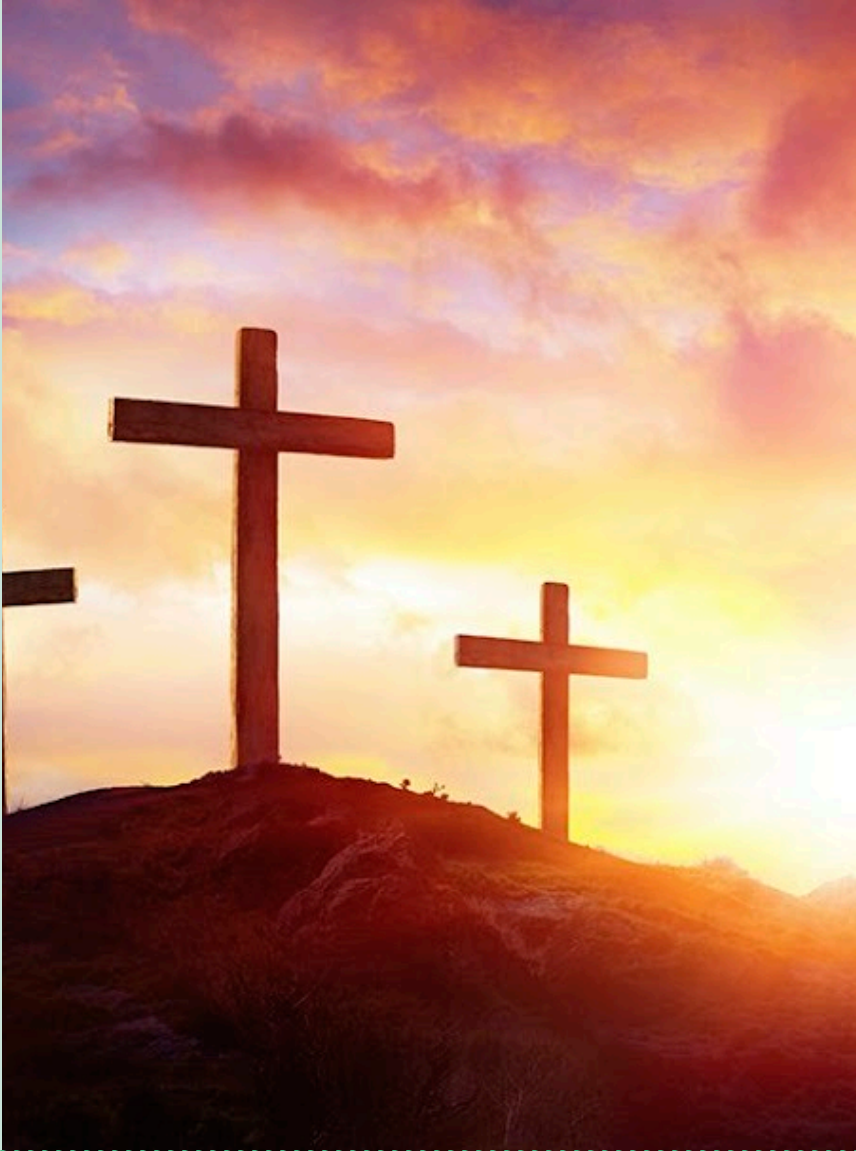
Frequent mental or emotional

Family history of suicides

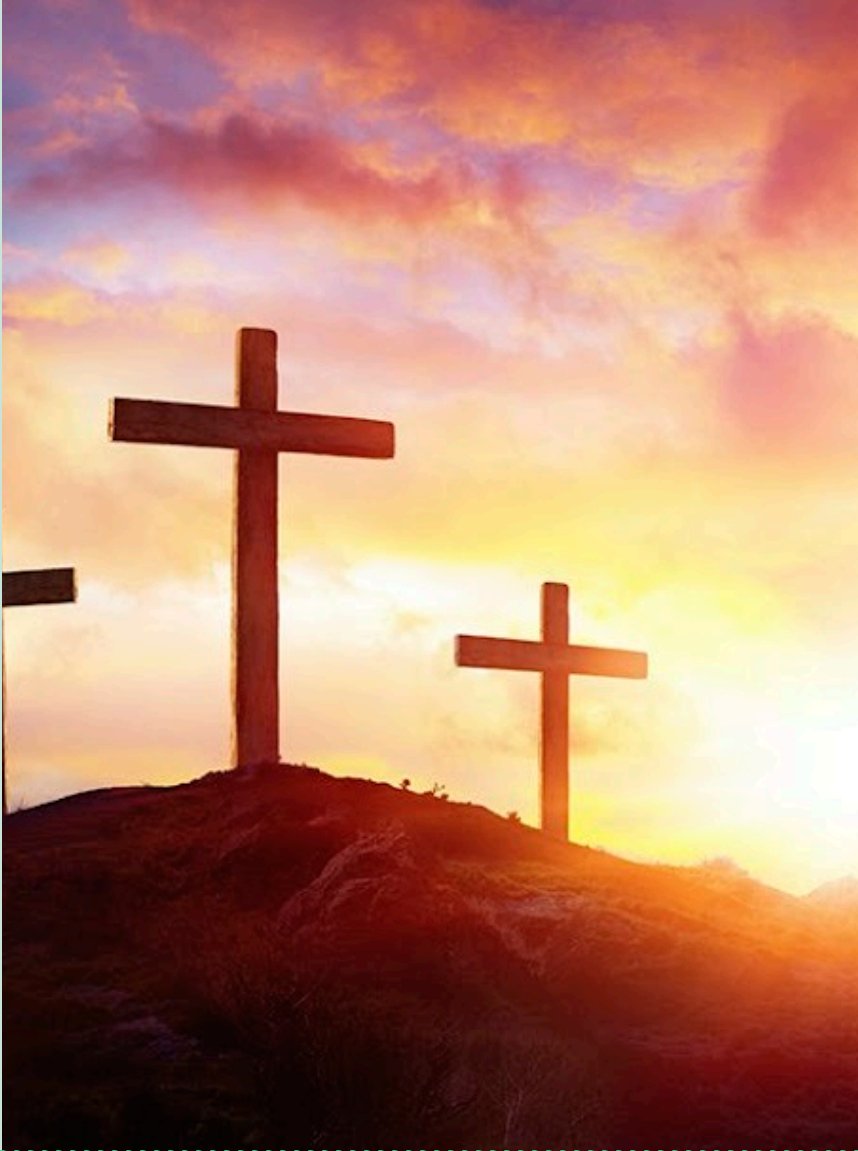
Night terrors

A Sample Prayer for Deliverance

A Sample Prayer for Deliverance (2)

Break every unhealthy relationship that's not pleasing in your sight. Release my family from every generational curse and demon that comes with it. I plead the blood of Jesus that breaks every chain. I claim you over all else. My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. I claim discipline. Your praise shall continually be in my mouth. Hide your Word in my heart that I might not sin against You. Wrap me in the garment of praise! Release me from the spirit of heaviness. I claim freedom in Christ Jesus. I am no longer bound by my past. I am not a prisoner to my guilt. Thank you for driving out every oppressor and renewing a right spirit in me. Thank you, Lord for taking control of my home. Everything that is mine is yours. Because You are able to keep me from falling, I trust You with my life. In Jesus's name, Amen.
